

University of Texas Taekwon-Do Club ITF Competition Team Brief

Requirements to be a member of the UT Taekwon-Do Club ITF, competition team, and represent the club at the World Cup to be held in Brighton, England, October 3-8, 2012. See: www.itfworldcup2012.com

1. You must be selected as one of the team members through one of the two tryouts to be held in the Fall semester of 2011 and the Spring semester of 2012. Three Men (+ 1 alternate) and Three Women (+1 alternate) competitors will be selected.
2. You must be a student, faculty or staff member in good standing, of the University of Texas at Austin, and hold a rec. sports facility pass.
3. You must maintain a 2.5 GPA during the training period (October 2011 to October 2012) if you are a student.
4. You must attend 2 training session per week with the University of Texas TKD Club ITF, and you must make all mandatory preparation meetings, including participation in two local tournaments.
5. You must have a valid passport, and be able to travel internationally.
6. You must have a Blue Belt, 5th geup, or higher rank. If you are a black belt, you must have your rank approved by the coaching staff. If you have no official rank, then coaches will assign rank according to ability.
7. You must purchase with your own funds, an approved dobok, sparring gear, and official warm up jacket. (approx. \$200.00)

If the above requirements are met, then the University of Texas TKD Club will sponsor your trip, including cost of flight, accommodations, and tournament entry fees, for the week associated with the tournament. All food purchases will be the responsibility of the competitors.

Criteria for Tryout selection:

1. Previous experience with ITF sparring and patterns, or similar striking art competitions.
2. Physical ability and potential to be victorious at the World Cup after 1 year of intensive training with UT TKD ITF coaching staff.
3. Attitude.
4. Ability to meet the requirements of competition team members.
